The NWTF also strives to identify a person for this position who agrees that the support of women is key to ensuring our hunting heritage is passed to future generations.

The Women's Coordinator will need to possess vision and determination to develop and grow a grassroots outdoor program – concentrating on developing and increasing the number of events including fundraising within our chapter system.

Women in the Outdoors Coordinator Job Duties:

- Work under the direct supervision of the Director of Field Operations with the primary responsibility to develop the Women in the Outdoors program.

- In conjunction with PA NWTF staff, work to expand new chapters where this is feasible within the main direction of building the Women in the Outdoors program.
- Identify potential volunteer leaders for Women in the Outdoors committees.
- Act as a liaison between chapters and national headquarters on various issues of importance.
- Work to improve the chapters' understanding of the National Wild Turkey Federation and the role Women in the Outdoors and other outreach programs play in building a successful chapter.
- Promote all levels of membership support to the NWTF.
- Gather and disseminate information to publicize field activities back to *Turkey Country* magazine.
